- Bill imports using freight collect without sharing your account number
- Exporters do not need a UPS account



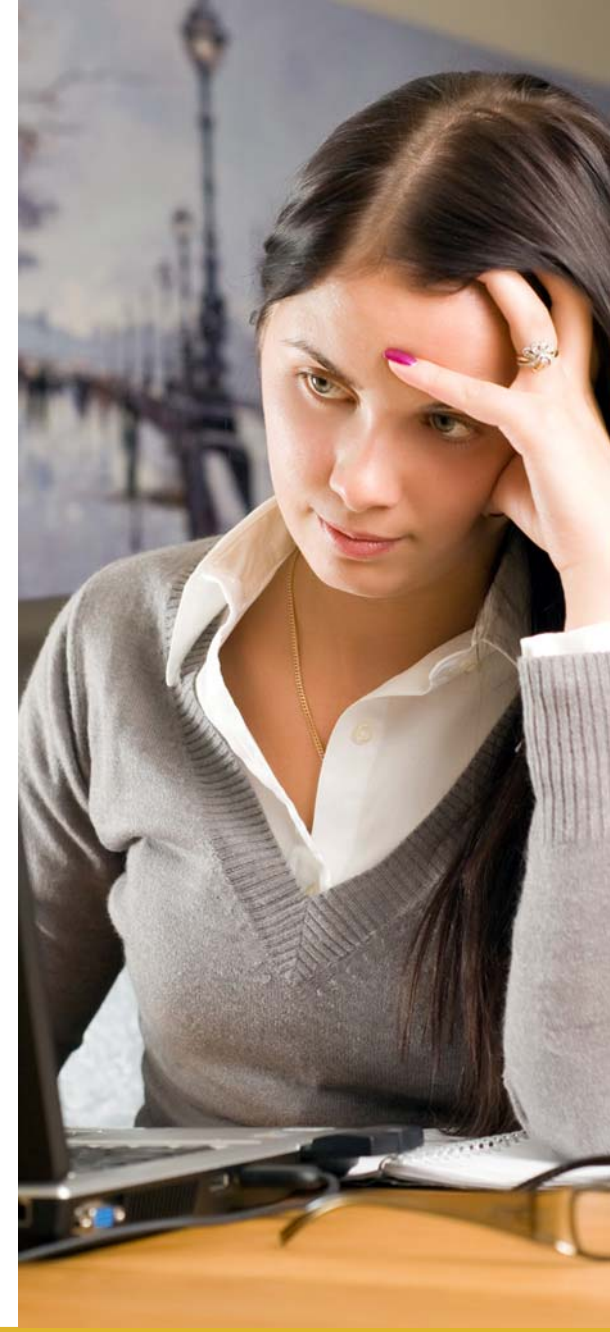

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keeping cost of goods on a commercial invoice confidential when sending to a third party	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can't ship to a third party directly, requiring a costly, time-consuming reshipment
